- -Student must be an active member of FHF and complete <u>at least one</u> of the following: successfully complete pathway choices/classes in the areas of early childhood education and teacher education or health occupations, work as an Adapted PE (or special education class) student intern through the Work Based Learning Program, **and/or** volunteer and log a substantial number of hours assisting with FHF trips and events as an active member of the FHF Officers Committee.
- -Complete attached application.
- -Student as they have opportunities / as they pursue a college degree must commit to stay involved in supporting/encouraging children who have special needs through FHF or similar organizations.
- -Required: Supply a list of extra-curricular school and club activities, community activities, and employment history during your middle and high school years. Include years of involvement, honors/awards, and positions of leadership.
- -Optional: Ask (3) teachers to write a recommendation as to why they they believe you deserve the FHF Scholarship. Ask them at least two weeks in advance to give them plenty of time to complete your request.

Note: Even if you have been awarded a <u>full</u> college scholarship, you are still eligible to receive a FHF Scholarship Recipient plaque and recognition! If you have been awarded a <u>partial</u> college scholarship, you are eligible to receive a FHF Scholarship and plaque. Scholarship checks <u>for tuition only</u> provided by Friends Helping Friends Club, Inc. are made out to and mailed directly to the college. <u>FHF Scholarship Recipients must follow the directions on the FHF Scholarship Recipient Instructions letter</u>. This letter will be <u>presented to FHF Scholarship Recipients during the ECCHS Senior Scholarship Night Ceremony</u>.
